


Command Description

The Move Line command enables you to select a line or multiple lines and move left or right a small amount without needing to copy and offset.



Tip!
In some cases duplicate and/or vertical nodes can cause problems while offsetting lines horizontally. Consider using the Line Node Cleanup command prior to Move Line to mitigate these issues.

1. Click in the **Line** selection field and then in a graphic view select the line or lines which you want to move. Click **Options** for additional selection options.
2. Pick the **Direction** to move the line.
3. Enter the **Distance** in the box you want to move the line by.

The **Line Direction - Show** check box will turn on/off the direction arrows and the **Options** button is a short cut to the line direction options. See Show Line Direction Options Command for more details.

4. Click **Apply** to apply the changes and **Close** to when finished with the command pane.

Note: If the line being moved contains vertical segments which are 5mm or less in horizontal length then the segment will be pushed to make it 5mm horizontally in the direction of the previous line segment.
